

## **NOTICE TO CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS, LABOR UNIONS AND PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS**

The Platte County Board of Commissioners intend to solicit assistance from the Wyoming Army National Guard under an Innovative Readiness Construction Assistance Program. The assistance will be for localized bulk dirt excavation along specific sections of South Guernsey Road and / or Tank Farm Road, south of Guernsey, Wyoming. Depending on NG unit availability, the work will be performed during Army National Guard Fiscal Year 2017 – 2018. Limited local funds are available for this project and will be applied to matching WYDOT IRP funding. By performing the localized dirt work, the NG assistance allows Platte County to upgrade more miles of the roadway given a fixed amount of IRP funding.
