PROPOSITION NO. 1 PLATTE COUNTY PROJECT

\$4,875,000.00 TO BE COLLECTED, TOGETHER WITH INTEREST EARNED THEREON TO BE USED BY PLATTE COUNTY FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, REMODELING, EQUIPPING AND FURNISHING FOR PHASE 1 OF REMODELING THE PLATTE COUNTY COURTHOUSE?

PROPOSITION NO. 2 PLATTE COUNTY FAIR BOARD PROJECT

\$4,720,000.00 TO BE COLLECTED, TOGETHER WITH INTEREST EARNED THEREON TO BE USED BY THE PLATTE COUNTY FAIR BOARD FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, REMODELING, EQUIPPING AND FURNISHINGS TO RENOVATE THE 4-H BUILDING ON THE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS, AND TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY AND ALLOWED BY LAW, THE PLEDGE TO OR PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE AND/OR LEASE PAYMENTS THEREON?

- B. \$413,000.00 TO THE TOWN OF GLENDO TO BE USED FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATIONS TO CONVERT THE OLD TOWN SHOP INTO A COMMUNITY CENTER;
- C. \$2,950,000.00 TO THE TOWN OF GUERNSEY TO BE USED FOR UPGRADES TO THE TOWN'S WATER SYSTEM, INCLUDING REFURBISHING THE WATER TANK AND PIPELINES, AND INSTALLING A DEDICATED WATER LINE WITH CHLORINATION;
- D. \$336,300.00 TO THE TOWN OF HARTVILLE FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN'S WATER PIPELINE AND CEMETERY, IMPROVEMENTS TO THE FIREHOUSE AND TOWN SHOP BUILDING, AND THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT;

THE PLATTE COUNTY SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICE DISTRICT IS SEEKING THE APPROVAL OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS WITHIN THE DISTRICT TO CONTINUE TO IMPOSE A TAX NOT TO EXCEED TWO (2) MILLS ON THE TAXABLE PROPERTY OF THE DISTRICT.

THE PLATTE COUNTY RESOURCE DISTRICT IS SEEKING THE APPROVAL OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS WITHIN THE COUNTY TO CONTINUE TO IMPOSE A CONSERVATION DISTRICT TAX NOT TO EXCEED ONE (1) MILL ON PROPERTY.

SHALL THE PLATTE COUNTY HOSPITAL DISTRICT CONTINUE THE MILL LEVY INCREASE FROM THREE (3) MILLS TO SIX (6) MILLS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO SUPPORT THE PLATTE COUNTY NURSING HOME AND OTHER DISTRICT SERVICES (IE: HOSPITAL AND ASSISTED LIVING)?

W.S. 22-25-105 THRU 22-25-109. A CANDIDATE WHO FAILS TO FILE FULL AND COMPLETE ITEMIZED STATEMENTS WILL BE SUBJECT TO PENALTIES PRESCRIBED IN W.S. 22-25-108.
