PERMANENT FUNDS OF THE STATE INCLUDE FUNDS DESIGNATED AS PERMANENT FUNDS BY THE CONSTITUTION. THE WYOMING CONSTITUTION DOES NOT ALLOW THE STATE TO INVEST ANY OTHER FUNDS IN EQUITIES.
