

Important Motor Vehicle State Fee Changes

Any vehicle licensed after 7/1/17 will be subject to pricing based on the new law.

Because of Legislative changes to Wyoming Statute 31-3-101 (a) (ii) (A), (B), (D), (E) (I) through (VI) & 31-18-401 (a) (ii) (A) & (iii) the state fee portion of your motor vehicle will increase 7/1/17.

The law changes your vehicle's State Fee portion only - the County Fee will remain the same.

Passenger Cars/SUV's	\$ 15.00	\$ 30.00	\$ 15.00
School Buses	\$ 10.00	\$ 25.00	\$ 15.00
Motorcycles	\$ 12.00	\$ 25.00	\$ 13.00
ATV's	\$ 12.00	\$ 25.00	\$ 13.00

All other vehicles which have State Fees Based on Weight

1 - 1,000	\$ 2.00	\$ 5.00	\$ 3.00
1,001 - 3,500	\$ 15.00	\$ 30.00	\$ 15.00
3,501 - 4,500	\$ 20.00	\$ 40.00	\$ 20.00
4,501 - 5,500	\$ 30.00	\$ 50.00	\$ 20.00
5,501 - 6,000	\$ 40.00	\$ 70.00	\$ 30.00
6,001 and over	\$ 60.00	\$ 90.00	\$ 30.00
